Make tech youth education available to all

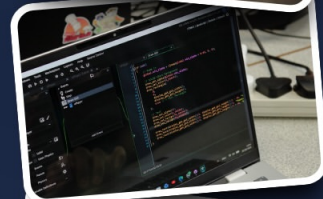
Providing access to hackathons, mentorship programs, and practical coding experiences for students aged 16 to 18.

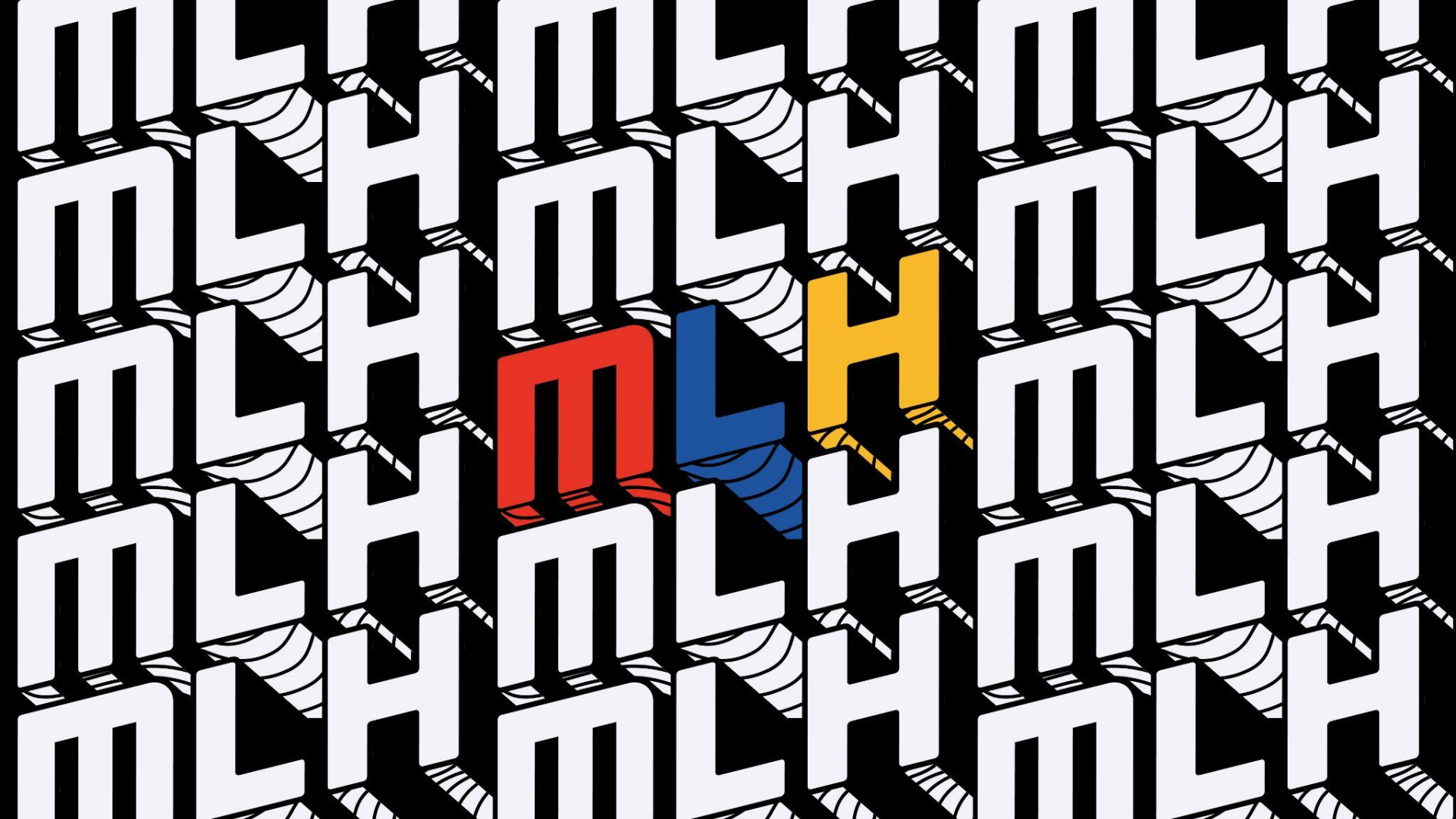

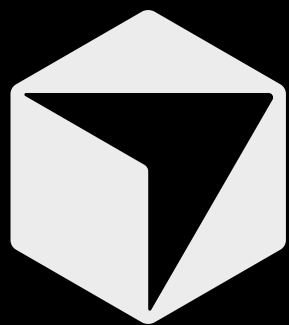
